## **PARRETT MANUFACTURING, INC. LIMITED WARRANTY**

Parrett Manufacturing, Inc. warrants, subject to the conditions and restrictions contained below, that each stile and rail door manufactured and sold by Parrett Manufacturing, Inc. shall: be free from defects in materials and workmanship from the time of manufacture until the time specified below:

- Warranty Period: two (2) years

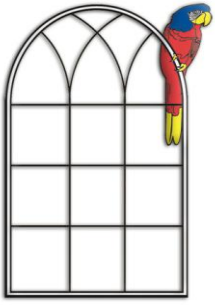
Product is available unfinished, primed or prefinished. Pre-hanging is available.

If a Parrett Manufacturing, Inc. door fails to conform to this written warranty, Parrett Manufacturing, Inc will, at its option, either repair the door, ship a replacement door to the distributor or person making the warranty claim in the same condition of fitting or finishing as the door was originally sold by Parrett Manufacturing, Inc., or refund the original purchase price paid for invoiced door. **Parrett Manufacturing, Inc. will not pay for the cost of labor, installation or finishing of the replacement or original door or for any other cost relating to the replacement of the door, all of which shall be the sole responsibility of the person making the warranty claim.**

**All visible defects or mistakes in shipment must be reported to Parrett Manufacturing, Inc. before the product is installed or trimmed, otherwise product shall be deemed correct and/or acceptable.**

**The following shall not be considered defects in material or workmanship and are not covered by this limited warranty:**

1. Natural variations in the color or texture of the wood;
2. Damage caused by others or by any cause beyond the control of Parrett Manufacturing, Inc., including but not limited to damage caused by misuse\*, abuse, accident, mishandling or by fire, flood, earthquake, storm, tornado or other acts of nature;
3. Warp for any door wider than 42" or taller than 96".
4. Warp for any nominal 1.75" thick by 42" wide by 96" high or smaller door, not exceeding .25" in the plane of the door itself;
5. Bow or nonalignment in the frame or jamb in which the door is hung if such is purchased from Parrett Manufacturing, Inc. un-machined and not pre-hung;
6. Variations or unsatisfactory results in gloss level, texture or appearance resulting from the field application of paint or any other finishing material.
7. The discoloration or rusting of decorative metal accent options, (Grilles, Clavos, Straps, etc.)

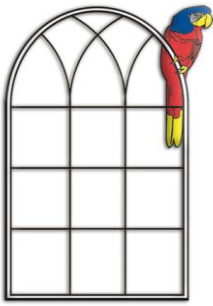

8. Knot placement, quantity, or size found on knotty alder;
9. Raised grain found on wire brushed surface;
10. Damage due to trimming more than .50 inch from the top or 1.50 inch from the bottom
11. Damage caused by failure to comply with the care, handling or finishing instructions provide by Parrett Manufacturing, Inc.; to include but not limited to damage caused by failing to seal all six (6) sides of the door.;
12. Failure to perform normal homeowners maintenance, including maintaining the finish whether it is a factory finish or a non-factory finish;
13. Product failure due to improper or incorrect installation;
14. Attempts to repair Parrett products by a non authorized Parrett employee.
15. Hardwood surface checks that are less that 1/32 of an inch and/or 2.0 inches in length. Knotty Alder surface checks that are less than .125 inch in width and/or 5.0 inches in length;
16. Panel movement or shrinkage of .25 of an inch or less. Temperature and humidity may cause the wood panels in your door to shrink, leaving an unstained line along the panel edge. The panels in your door have been designed to float.
17. Damage caused by extreme temperature buildup where a storm door is utilized. Storm doors must be vented to eliminate this heat buildup;
18. Slight expansion or contraction due to varying environmental conditions, such as temperature and humidity;
19. Doors shipped out of continental United States, Hawaii or Canada are not warranted.
20. It the claimed non-conformity is warp, Parrett Manufacturing, Inc. may defer repairing or replacing the product for a period of up to twelve (12) months from the date of claim or the date when the product was installed, as it is not uncommon for a temporary warp condition to occur as the door adjust to local humidity and temperature conditions. This deferral will not be counted against the warranty period.

\*Misuse of a door includes, but is not limited to, using a door on part of a building without providing adequate overhang or an appropriate finish color. Adequate overhang depends on the climate for the area where the door is to be used. Refer to the Parrett Manufacturing, Inc. recommended overhang guideline chart or contact Parrett for specific instructions. Typically, Northern regions require an overhang projecting a distance from the door structure one-half the elevation difference between the base of the overhang (measured at the furthest point from the door) and the bottom of the door. Typically, Southern regions require a distance measuring two times the difference between the base of the overhang (measured at the furthest point from the door) and the bottom of the door.

Dark colored finishes should be avoided on all surfaces, especially on light colored wood species, or if the door is exposed to sunlight to avoid warping. Parrett Manufacturing, Inc. is not responsible for determining the suitability of a specific location. It is incumbent upon the buyer of the door to determine the suitability for its location.

Claims under this Limited Warranty must be made in writing within the period of this warranty and prior to the beginning of any repair work. Qualifying claims can be submitted to: Warranty Claims, Parrett Manufacturing, Inc., 810 Second Avenue East, Dorchester, WI 54425. Claims should;

1. Detail the date and location of purchase;
2. Explain the nature of the problem;
3. Identify the name, address and telephone number of the person making the claim.

Parrett Manufacturing, Inc. reserves the right and must be given at least a thirty (30) day opportunity to have any door which is subject of a warranty claim to be field inspected by a Parrett authorized representative.

**THIS LIMITED WARRANTY EXTENDS ONLY TO THE ORIGINAL PURCHASER OF PRODUCTS OR TO THE ORIGINAL PURCHASER OF THE STRUCTURE INTO WHICH SUCH PRODUCTS ARE INSTALLED.**

PARRETT MAKES NOT OTHER WARRANTY, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURCHASE, WITH RESPECT TO ITS PRODUCTS EXCEPT AS IT IS SET FORTH ABOVE. NO DISTRIBUTOR, DEALER OR REPRESENTATIVE HAS THE AUTHORITY TO CHANGE OR MODIFY THIS LIMITED WARRANTY. IN NO INSTANCE SHALL PARRETT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR INDIRECT, CONSEQUENTIAL OR INCIDENTAL DAMAGES.**
